

PUBLIC INFO MEETING IS APRIL 26 FOR WALTON BLVD.

The Road Commission for Oakland County (RCOC), in partnership with the cities of Auburn Hills and Rochester Hills, will host a public information meeting Thursday, April 26, to share information about the planned 2018 project on Walton Blvd. between Squirrel Rd. and Adams Rd. The work will start in mid-to-late May or early June.


MEETING DETAILS

WHAT: Public information meeting to discuss the construction plans and the impact on traffic during construction.

WHEN: Thursday, April 26, 4 pm to 7 pm.

WHERE: Auburn Hills Public Library, 3400 E. Seyburn Dr., Auburn Hills

NOTE: The meeting will be “open house” format. There will not be a formal presentation. Anyone can attend any time between 4 pm and 7 pm to review information and speak with an RCOC representative.



PROJECT DETAILS

The project involves the replacement of three large metal culverts under this section of Walton Blvd. with concrete box culverts. The project also includes road-base repairs and repaving with two inches of new asphalt as well as concrete curb and gutter repair.

IMPACT ON TRAFFIC

Two-way traffic will be maintained throughout the project, though one side of the boulevard will be closed at all times. Motorists should expect delays especially during rush hours.

Traffic will first be shifted to the north side of Walton (normally the westbound lanes) while the culverts are replaced under the eastbound lanes. (south side of the boulevard). Once the south side is complete, traffic will be shifted to the south side of Walton, and work will take place on the north side.

Access to homes and businesses along this section of

Walton will be maintained at all times during the project.

Resurfacing will occur after the culverts have been replaced and may take place in 2018 or spring 2019.

FUNDING

This project is expected to cost approximately \$5.8 million. \$5.7 million will be funded by RCOC, and \$100,000 will be funded by the City of Auburn Hills.
