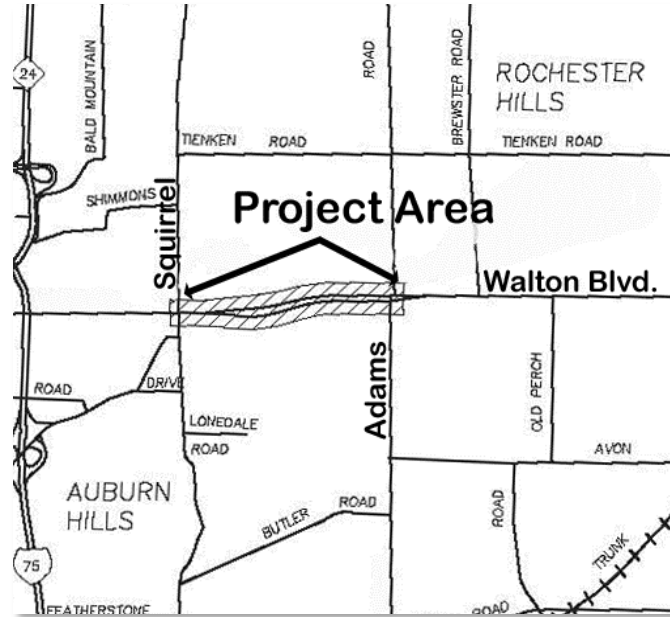


PROJECT INFORMATION FOR 2018 WALTON BLVD.



PROJECT DETAILS

This project involves the replacement of three large metal culverts under the section of Walton Blvd. between Adams Road and Squirrel Road with concrete box culverts. The project also includes road-base repairs and repaving with two inches of new asphalt as well as concrete curb and gutter repair.

IMPACT ON TRAFFIC

Two-way traffic will be maintained throughout the project, though one side of the boulevard will be closed at all times. Motorists should expect delays especially during rush hours.

Traffic will first be shifted to the north side of Walton (normally the westbound lanes) while the culverts are replaced under the eastbound lanes. (south side of the boulevard). Once the south side is complete, traffic will be shifted to the south side of Walton, and work will take place on the north side. Access to home and businesses along this section of Walton

will be maintained at all times during the project.

However, Bellarmine and Firewood Drives will be closed at Walton starting approximately June 2. Resurfacing will occur after the culverts have been replaced and may take place in 2018 or spring 2019.

FUNDING

This project is expected to cost approximately \$5.8 million. \$5.7 million will be funded by Road Commission for Oakland County (RCOC), and the remaining \$100,000 will be provided by the City of Auburn Hills.
