EAST LEG OF DEQUINDRE/AUBURN INTERSECTION TO CLOSE AUG. 12 THROUGH EARLY SEPTEMBER

Beverly Hills, MI— The Road Commission for Oakland County (RCOC) expects to close the east leg of the Dequindre Road/Auburn Road intersection on the Rochester Hills/Shelby Township border from Aug. 12 through early September as part of the ongoing Dequindre Road widening project from Utica Road to Collins Avenue.

During the closure, access to homes and business property along this section of Auburn Road will be maintained. The detour for Auburn Road through traffic is Dequindre Road to Hamlin Road to Ryan Road back to Auburn Road and vice versa.

This section of Dequindre Road carries approximately 18,110 vehicles, while Auburn Road carries approximately 11,800 vehicles.
