

## 12 MILE TO BE REPAVED BETWEEN FARMINGTON AND ORCHARD LAKE THIS SUMMER

The Road Commission for Oakland County (RCOC), in partnership with the City of Farmington Hills, will repave 12 Mile Road between Farmington Road and Orchard Lake Road and in Farmington Hills this summer.

### **PROJECT DETAILS**

The project will include removing the asphalt surface from this section of 12 Mile Road. The road will then be repaved with three inches of new asphalt. The project also includes:

- Reconstructing of deteriorated side street approaches
- Upgrading of pedestrian crosswalks to comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA)
- Upgrading of traffic and pedestrian-crossing signals
- Repairing of curbs and gutters
- Replacing traffic signs and pavement markings

### **SCHEDULE**

Road construction is expected to take place in summer and fall of 2021.

### **IMPACT ON TRAFFIC**

One lane of traffic in each direction will remain open on this section of 12 Mile Road at all times during the project.



### **PROJECT COST AND FUNDING**

The project is expected to cost \$1.75 million. Eighty percent of the cost will be paid for with federal road funds. The remainder of the costs will be shared by RCOC and the City of Farmington Hills.
