

## INFO MEETING WILL BE OCT. 4 FOR OAKWOOD & HADLEY INTERSECTION PAVING PROJECT

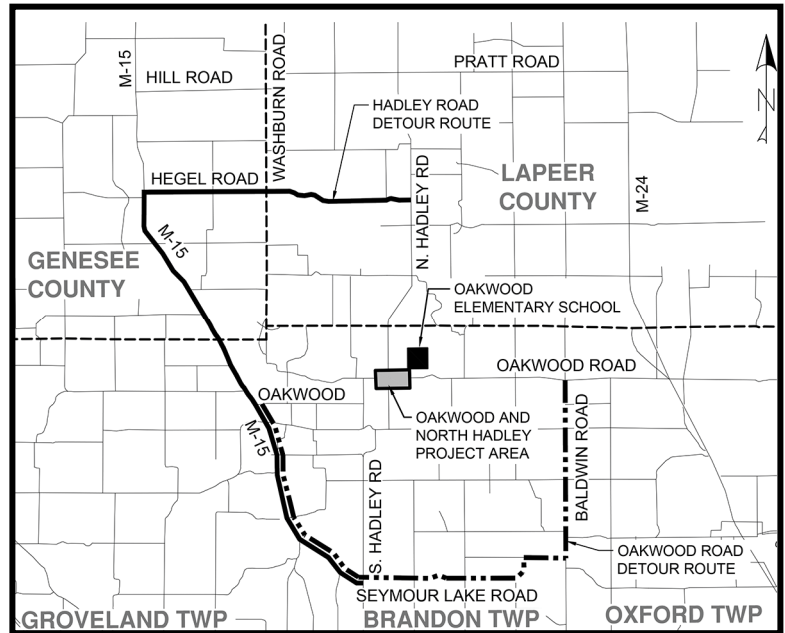
The Road Commission for Oakland County (RCOC), in partnership with Brandon Township, will conduct a public information meeting Tuesday, Oct. 4, about the upcoming improvement project at the Oakwood Road/Hadley Road intersection.

### **MEETING DETAILS**

**Date/time:** Tuesday, Oct. 4, 4:30 p.m. to 7 p.m.

**Meeting details:** The meeting will be open-house format; there will not be a formal presentation. Anyone interested can review plans and talk with RCOC staff at any time during the meeting.

**Location:** Oakwood Elementary School, 2839 Oakwood Road in Brandon Township.



### **PROJECT DETAILS**

The project will include:

- Extending the Oakwood Road center left-turn lane from Oakwood Elementary school west through the intersection.
- Replacement of the culvert under the intersection.
- Widening the Oakwood Road shoulders to six feet.
- Adding curbs and gutters throughout the intersection.
- Improving the storm sewer and drainage at the intersection.

### **IMPACT ON TRAFFIC**

The intersection will be closed during the project. Access to area homes and businesses will be maintained at all times. The **detour routes** are:

- **Oakwood traffic:** Baldwin Road to Seymour Lake

Road to Ortonville Road (M-15) and back to Oakwood and vice versa.

- **Hadley Road traffic:** Seymour Lake Road to Ortonville Road (M-15) to Hegel Road and back to Hadley Road and vice versa.

### **SCHEDULE**

- Utility work will take place in the fall of 2022 and the winter of 2022-23.
- Road construction will start in the summer of 2023 and be completed in the fall.

### **PROJECT COST AND FUNDING**

The project will cost approximately \$1.7 million and will be paid for with a combination of federal road funds and dollars from RCOC.
