

## INFO MEETING WILL BE NOV. 29 FOR PLANNED ORION/STONEY CREEK/CONKLIN ROUNDABOUT

The Road Commission for Oakland County (RCOC), in partnership with Orion Township, will conduct a public information meeting Tuesday, Nov. 29, about the planned 2023 construction of a roundabout at the intersection of Orion, Stoney Creek and Conklin roads.

### MEETING DETAILS

**Date/time:** Tuesday, Nov. 29, 4:30 p.m. to 7 p.m.

**Meeting details:** The meeting will be open-house format; there will not be a formal presentation. Anyone interested can review plans and talk with RCOC staff at any time during the meeting.

**Location:** Blanche Sims Elementary School, 465 East Jackson Street, Lake Orion, MI 48362.

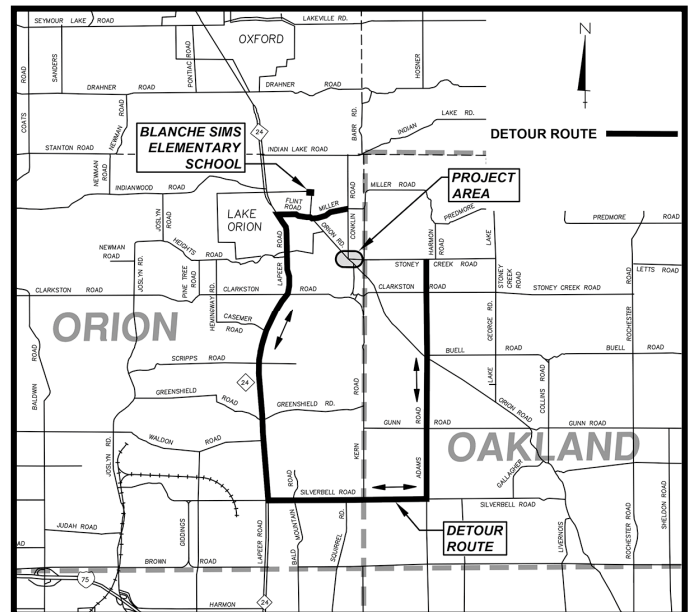
### PROJECT DETAILS

The project will include:

- Constructing a modern roundabout at the Orion Road/Stoney Creek Road intersection with Conklin Road becoming a “T” intersection with Orion Road north of the roundabout.
- Paving the new roundabout with asphalt.
- Constructing new Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) compliant crosswalks.
- Connecting the pedestrian crosswalks to the existing pedestrian pathway.
- Improving the storm sewers and drainage.
- Installing intersection lighting.

### IMPACT ON TRAFFIC

- The intersection will be closed to traffic during construction.
- Access to homes and businesses will be maintained at all times.
- The **detour route** during the closure will be: Adams Road to Silver Bell Road to Lapeer Road



(M-24) to Flint Street to Miller Road to Conklin Road and vice versa.

### SCHEDULE

- Utility relocation will take place during the winter of 2022/2023 and the spring of 2023.
- Tree removal will take place during the winter of 2023.
- Roundabout construction (with road closure) is expected to start in summer 2023 and be completed in fall 2023.

### PROJECT COST AND FUNDING

The project will cost approximately \$1.6 million and will be paid for with federal funds as well as RCOC and Orion Township dollars.
