

RCOC TO REPLACE CULVERT UNDER COOLEY LAKE ROAD IN SUMMER OF 2023

The Road Commission for Oakland County (RCOC) will replace the culvert that carries the Huron River under Cooley Lake Road west of Carroll Lake Road on the White Lake Township/Commerce Township border in 2023.

PROJECT DETAILS

The project includes:

- Removing the existing culvert under Cooley Lake Road and replacing it with a pre-cast concrete bridge.
- Placement of curbs and gutters along Cooley Lake Road.
- Replacement of the guardrails near the new bridge.
- Removal and replacement of the pavement and minor storm sewer improvements around the new bridge.

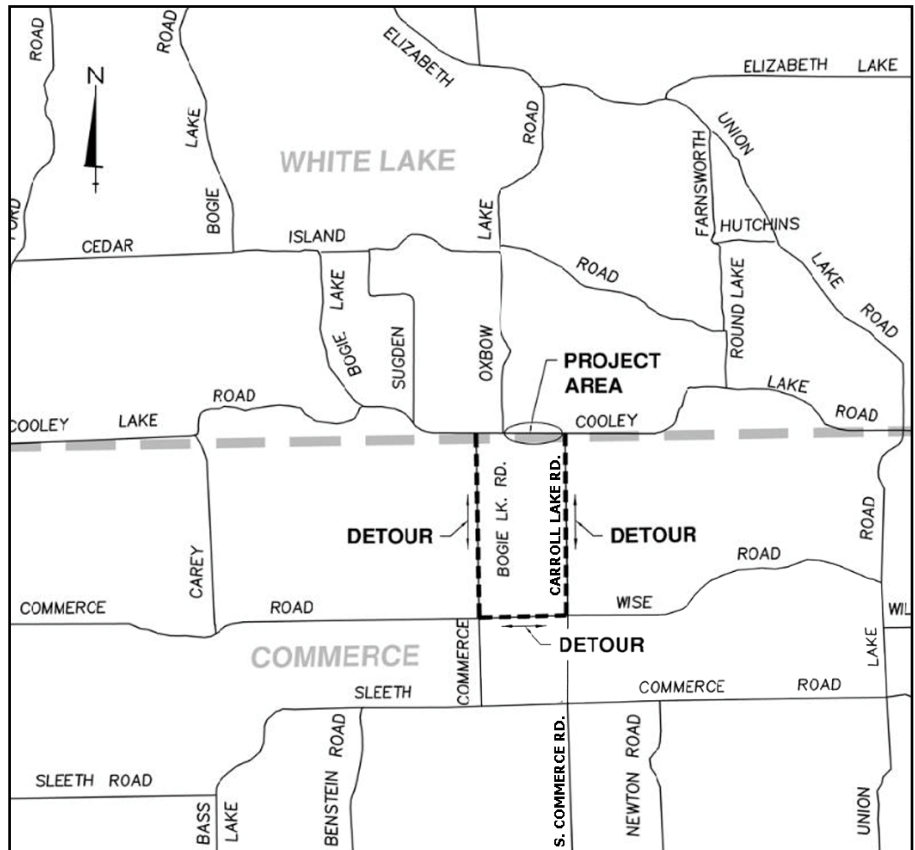
IMPACT ON TRAFFIC

Cooley Lake Road will be closed to through traffic between Carroll Lake Road and Oxbow Lake Road during the project.

The **detour route** will be Carroll Lake Road to Wise Road to Bogie Lake Road and back to Cooley Lake Road and vice versa.

SCHEDULE

Work will start in early July 2023, with completion in the fall of 2023.



PROJECT COST AND FUNDING

The project will cost approximately \$2.45 million and will be paid for with a combination of federal road funds and RCOC dollars.

CONTRACTOR

The work will be performed by Anlaan Corporation of Grand Haven.
