

MAPLE ROAD RESURFACING PROJECT PUBLIC INFO MEETING WILL BE TUESDAY, OCT. 25

The Road Commission for Oakland County (RCOC) will resurface Maple Road from Drake Road to Haggerty Road in West Bloomfield Township in 2017.

There will be a public information meeting about the project on Tuesday, Oct. 25. Here are the meeting details:

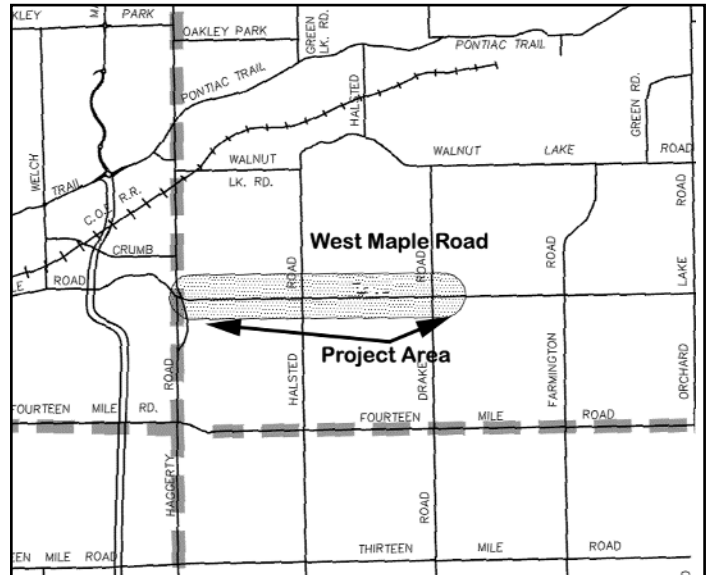
- WHEN:** Tuesday, Oct. 25, 4-7 p.m.
- LOCATION:** West Bloomfield Public Library

- FORMAT:** This meeting will be open-house format. There will not be any formal presentations, but anyone can attend at any time to speak with an RCOC representative.

PROJECT DETAILS:

RCOC will resurface this two-mile section of Maple Road. The project will include adding a continuous center left-turn lane. It will also include some right-turn-lane extensions, paved-shoulder widenings, curb and gutter installation, storm sewer installation, drainage improvements and pedestrian crosswalk upgrades. Some trees will be removed at the Halsted/Maple intersection. Halsted Road is a Natural Beauty Road.

IMPACT ON TRAFFIC

Throughout this project, Maple Road from west of Henry Ford West Bloomfield Hospital to Haggerty Road will remain open for eastbound traffic to ensure access to the hospital, but will be closed for westbound traffic. The road will remain open to two-way traffic between the hospital and Drake Road. It will be completely closed for a short time for a culvert installation between Haggerty and Halsted roads.



During the project, the detour route for westbound through traffic will be 14 Mile Road. Access to all homes and businesses within the construction area will be maintained at all times.

Also, this project will occur at the same time that RCOC is reconstructing and widening Maple Road between Orchard Lake and Farmington roads. That section of Maple will be open to westbound traffic only to ensure access to the hospital.

COST/FUNDING

The project is expected to cost approximately \$5.5 million. The project will be paid for with a combination of federal and local dollars shared by RCOC and West Bloomfield Twp.
