**MISCELLANEOUS CURB REMOVAL**

**a. Description**

This work shall be done in accordance with section 204 of the *Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) 2020 Standard Specifications for Construction*, except as herein provided.

**b. Materials**

All work shall be in accordance with the contract documents. Backfill material shall be per the *Standard Specifications for Construction* or as approved by the Engineer.

**c. Construction**

All work shall be in accordance with the contract documents. Remove and dispose of existing materials located along the edge of pavements that are serving as existing curb type structures as determined by the Engineer when indicated in the contract documents.

1. Existing types of materials included in this pay item can include but not be limited to the following:
  - A. Materials requiring a separate action to be removed.
  - B. Non-integral HMA curb.
  - C. Integral HMA curb greater than 3 inches in height.
  - D. Timbers.
  - E. Bricks.
  - F. Blocks.
2. This work does not include the following existing materials to be removed:
  - A. Materials that are removed simultaneously in conjunction with underlying or adjacent materials that are paid for by other pay items.
  - B. HMA curb 3 inches or less in height.
  - C. Stone, rocks, boulders.
  - D. Soil.
  - E. Vegetation.
  - F. Landscape edging.
  - G. Concrete curb, concrete curb and gutter, concrete gutter.
3. Dispose of removed materials properly.
4. Backfill as required to construct the proposed cross section.

**d. Measurement and Payment**

The completed work, including all labor, equipment and material necessary to complete this work as described, will be measured and paid for at the contract unit price using the following pay item:

<b>Pay Item</b>	<b>Pay Unit</b>
Curb, Rem, Misc, SAD.....	Foot

Payment for **Curb, Rem, Misc, SAD** includes all costs for removal and disposal.

The Engineer will measure **Curb, Rem, Misc, SAD** as a separate pay item if it is a separate action for removal, and if it is not removed simultaneously in conjunction with other pay items, or in conjunction with pavement or driveway removal along the base of the curb face or along the flowline of the gutter.

If HMA curb is pulverized or milled in the same pass of the equipment that HMA pavement or HMA surface is being pulverized or milled, it is not a separate action and will not be measured and paid for separately as **Curb, Rem, Misc, SAD**.

Removals that do not meet the criteria are included in payment for other pay items, as directed by the Engineer. Removals will not be paid for twice by two different pay items.
