

## PUBLIC INFO MEETING WILL BE FEB. 12 FOR PONTIAC LAKE RD. PAVING PROJECT, MARGIE DR. TO ARLINGTON ST.

The Road Commission for Oakland County (RCOC), in partnership with White Lake Township, will conduct a public information meeting Thursday, Feb. 12, about the project to pave the gravel portion of Pontiac Lake Road between Margie Drive and Arlington Street (between M-59/Highland Road and Teggerdine Road) and construct a roundabout at Fisk Road. The work is expected to begin in late 2026, stop for the winter and resume in spring 2027.

### MEETING DETAILS

**WHAT:** Public information meeting to discuss the construction plans and the impact on traffic during construction.

**WHEN:** Thursday, Feb. 12

**WHERE:** White Lake Township Hall Annex, 7527 Highland Road, White Lake Twp., MI 48383 (the old library building behind Twp. Offices)

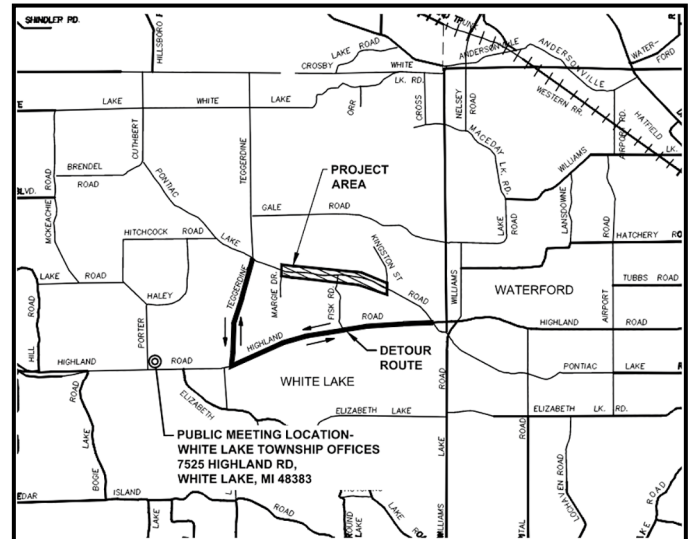
**NOTE:** The meeting will be “open house” format. There will not be a formal presentation. Anyone can attend between 4 p.m. and 7 p.m. to review information and speak with an RCOC representative.

### PROJECT DETAILS

- Paving the gravel section of Pontiac Lake Road between Margie Road and Arlington Street.
- Installation of curb and gutter where appropriate.
- Improvements to shoulders and drainage.
- Construction of a roundabout at the Pontiac Lake/Fisk intersection.
- Adjustments to the roadway alignment and profile to improve safety.
- Improvements to the stability of the soil under the road.

### IMPACT ON TRAFFIC

- During construction, Pontiac Lake Road will be closed



to through traffic between M-59/Highland Road and Teggerdine Road.

- Motorists will be able to access homes and businesses along Pontiac Lake Road between Margie Drive and Arlington Street from either end of the project, but cannot go completely through the construction area.
- During the project, the **detour route** for through traffic will be Teggerdine Road to Highland Road (M-59) and back to Pontiac Lake Road and vice versa.

### SCHEDULE

- Utility relocation work will take place in late summer and fall of 2026.
- Tree removal is expected to begin after Oct. 1 2026 and be completed by winter.
- Earthwork is expected to begin in late 2026, but will stop for the winter.
- The majority of road construction work will begin in the spring of 2027.

### PROJECT COST AND FUNDING

The project will cost \$5.8 million and will be paid for with federal funds and contributions from RCOC, White Lake Township and Oakland County general government (through the Tri-Party Program).
