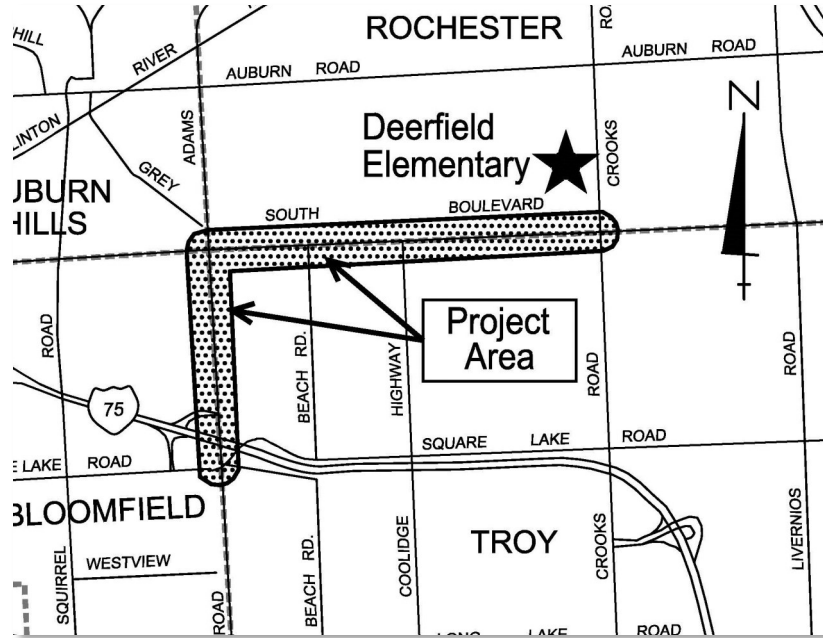


# PROJECT INFORMATION FOR THE 2018 SOUTH BLVD CULVERT REPLACEMENT



## **PROJECT DETAILS**

The section of South Blvd. from Coolidge to Crooks will be resurfaced. From Adams to Coolidge, the road will be partially reconstructed and resurfaced. Additionally, the Borden Drain culvert just west of Coolidge will be replaced and Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA)-compliant sidewalks, crosswalks and pedestrian signals will be installed.

## **SCHEDULE AND IMPACT ON TRAFFIC**

The resurfacing of South Blvd. between Coolidge and Crooks will take place beginning in June. The road will remain open during this work, but there will be lane closures and motorists should expect delays.

The Borden Drain culvert just west of Coolidge will be replaced after July 4. The road will be completely closed at the culvert during this time. The detour is Crooks Road to Square Lake Road to Squirrel Road, back to South Blvd. and vice versa.

Once the culvert is replaced, the partial

reconstruction of South Blvd. from Adams to Coolidge will take place. During that time, this section of South Blvd. will be open for westbound traffic only. Eastbound traffic will use the above detour route. The project is expected to be completed by mid-September. Access to homes, businesses and side streets along this section of South Blvd. will be maintained at all times during the project, except where the culvert is being replaced.

## **FUNDING**

This project is expected to cost approximately \$2.4 million. The cost is being shared by the Road Commission for Oakland County (RCOC), the cities of Troy and Rochester Hills and Oakland County general government (through the Tri-Party Program).
