PINE TREE ROAD FROM CLARKSTON ROAD TO HEIGHTS ROAD IN ORION TWP. TO CLOSE AUG. 6 FOR ROAD REHABILITATION

Beverly Hills, MI – The Road Commission for Oakland County (RCOC) plans to close Pine Tree Road from Clarkston Road to Heights Road in Orion Township on Aug. 6 for road rehabilitation.

The project is expected to be completed in mid-September.

The detour for through traffic is Clarkston Road to Joslyn Road to Heights Road, back to Pine Tree Road and vice versa. Access to homes within the project area will be maintained throughout the project.

The \$688,000 project will be funded by RCOC, Orion Township and Oakland County general government (through the Tri-Party Program). The project will include:

- Pulverizing the existing road surface
- Asphalt paving
- Construction of Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA)-compliant sidewalks
- Guardrail installation
