


SOUTH BLVD. OVER FERRY DRAIN CULVERT REPLACEMENT PROJECT TO START SEPT. 17



The Road Commission for Oakland County (RCOC), in partnership with the cities of Troy and Rochester Hills, will replace the South Blvd. culvert at the Ferry Drain between Rochester and John R roads. The work is expected to start on approximately Sept. 17 and be completed in early November.

PROJECT DETAILS

This project will include the removal and replacement of the culvert at the Ferry Drain. The contractor for this culvert replacement project is Z Contractors Inc. of Shelby Township.

IMPACT ON TRAFFIC

During construction, South Blvd. will be closed at the culvert and closed to through traffic between Rochester and John R roads. Local traffic will be maintained throughout construction. The detour route will be South Blvd. to Rochester Road to Auburn Road to John R Road, back to South Blvd. and vice versa.

FUNDING

This project is expected to cost approximately \$680,000 and will be funded by RCOC.
