## LEFT-TURNS TO BE TEMPORARILY PROHIBITED FROM SOUTHFIELD ROAD TO 10 MILE ROAD BEGINNING OCT. 18 FOR CONCRETE REPAIRS

**Beverly Hills, MI**— The Road Commission for Oakland County (RCOC), in cooperation with the City of Southfield, will temporarily prohibit left turns from both northbound and southbound Southfield Road to 10 Mile Road in Southfield beginning, Oct. 18.

The left-turn restrictions are part of the ongoing pavement repairs on 10 Mile Road from Greenfield Road to Evergreen Road that began July 8. During this phase of the project, the contractor will close the center left-turn lane and two adjacent lanes in each direction on Southfield Road to 10 Mile Road for concrete patching work.

Southfield Road at 10 Mile Road will have one through lane open for traffic in each direction. Motorists can expect delays and are advised to seek an alternate route.

This phase of work expected to be complete by Oct. 28; however, additional lane closures will remain in place for several days. The entire project will be completed in late fall.
