

TREE CLEARING ON ADAMS BETWEEN LONG LAKE & SQUARE LAKE TO START SOON; ROAD TO BE REPAVED THIS YEAR

The Road Commission for Oakland County (RCOC), in partnership with the City of Troy and Bloomfield Township, will rehabilitate and repave Adams Road between Long Lake and Square Lake roads, on the border of these two communities.

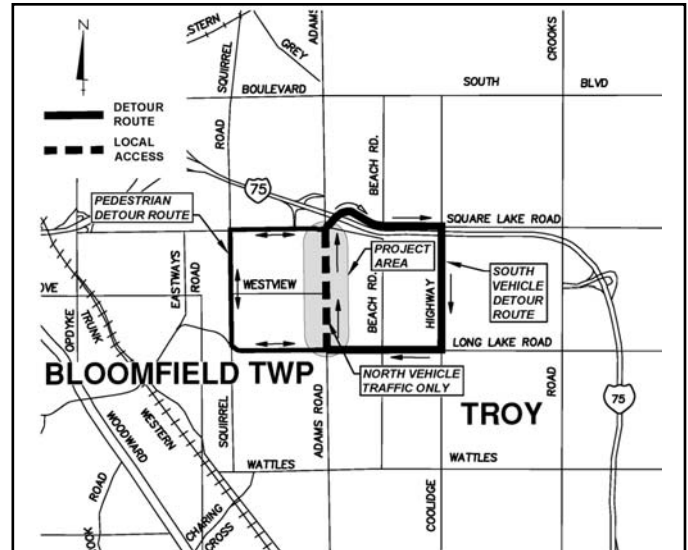
PROJECT DETAILS

The project will include milling (grinding off) the existing asphalt surface of the road followed by repaving with three inches of new asphalt. A new center, left-turn lane will be added between Vineyards Drive and Westview Road. Passing lanes and right-turn lanes will be extended in several locations. Other improvements include the installation of curbs and gutters, upgrading the pedestrian crosswalks to comply with Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) requirements and storm sewer and drainage improvements. The traffic signal at the intersection of Long Lake and Adams roads will also be upgraded.

IMPACT ON TRAFFIC

Throughout the project, northbound Adams Road will remain open to traffic. However, this section of Adams Road will be **closed to southbound traffic** throughout the project as well as to pedestrians in both directions.

Throughout the project, access to homes and businesses along the road will be maintained at all times via northbound Adams. The detour route for southbound Adams traffic will be Adams Road to Square Lake Road to Cooldidge Highway to Long Lake Road and back to Adams Road. The detour route for pedestrians who would normally use this section of Adams Road will be Adams Road to Long Lake Road to Squirrel Road to Square Lake Road and back to Adams Road and vice versa.



SCHEDULE

- ⇒ **Tree removal** will take place in the project area during March of 2021.
- ⇒ **Utility relocation** will take place in spring of 2021.
- ⇒ **Road construction** is expected to begin in summer 2021 and finish in the fall. **The road will be closed to southbound traffic during that time.**

Daytime single-lane closures are expected during the tree removal and utility relocation phases.

PROJECT COST AND FUNDING

The project is expected to cost \$2.6 million. Fifty-seven percent of the cost will be paid for with federal road funds. The remainder of the costs will be shared by RCOC and the City of Troy.
