### **WATTLES ROAD FROM BURNLEY RD TO CHARING CROSSING RD TO CLOSE TO THROUGH TRAFFIC BEGINNING JAN. 4**

**Beverly Hills, MI** – The Oakland County Water Resources Commissioner’s Office will close Wattles Road from Burnley Road to Charing Cross Road to through traffic in Bloomfield Township for sanitary sewer construction beginning Monday, January 4, 2016.

During the road closure, access will be maintained to homes along Wattles Road within the construction area. The detour route for through traffic will be Adams Road to Long Lake Road to Squirrel Road to Wattles Road and vice versa.

The contractor for the project is Angelo Iafrate Construction Company of Warren. Wattles Road is expected to re-open to traffic on approximately May 15, 2016.
