

PONTIAC TRAIL TO BE RESURFACED BETWEEN HAGGERTY AND GREEN LAKE IN 2022

The Road Commission for Oakland County (RCOC), in partnership with West Bloomfield Township, is seeking input on its plans to repave Pontiac Trail from Haggerty Road to Green Lake Road in 2022.

PROJECT DETAILS

The project will include:

- Removal of the existing pavement and replacement with 7.5 inches of new asphalt.
- Extension of the Pontiac Trail center, left-turn lane from Green Lake Road west to Parkridge Dr.
- Extension of the Green Lake Road southbound right-turn lane onto Pontiac Trail.
- Spot curb and gutter replacements.
- Upgraded pedestrian crosswalks to comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA).
- Improved merging of the right lane of eastbound Pontiac Trail just east of Haggerty.

SCHEDULE

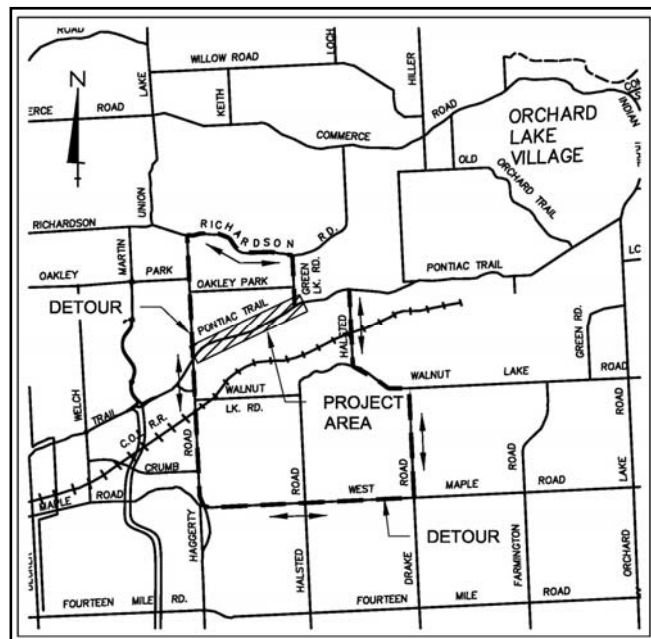
Work is expected to begin in **April 2022** and be completed by early fall 2022.

IMPACT ON TRAFFIC

This section of Pontiac Trail will be closed to through traffic throughout construction. Access to homes and businesses within the project will be maintained at all times.

The **detour route for westbound through traffic** during the closure will be Green Lake Road north to Richardson Road to Haggerty Road and back to Pontiac Trail.

The **detour route for eastbound Pontiac Trail through traffic** will be Haggerty Road south to Maple Road east to Drake Road, north to Walnut Lake Road, west to Halstead Road and north back to Pontiac Trail.



PROJECT COST AND FUNDING

The project is expected to cost \$2.5 million. Eighty percent of the cost will be paid for with federal funds. The remainder will be shared by RCOC, West Bloomfield Township and Oakland County general government (through the Tri-Party Program).
