Please ensure submissions are completed on the current worksheet by downloading them from our website at <https://www.rcocweb.org/315/Oakland-County-Federal-Aid-Committee-FAC> and navigating to "Project Application Materials" on the left. The 3R Project Submission Guide document is new and should be used when filling out the forms.

Please note that the RRR Project Activities Cost Estimate (PACE) form is available as a fillable Excel file which will perform calculations automatically. Also, construction activity costs should be generally in line with MDOT's most recent Pay Item Code costs.

Surface Transportation Program – Urban (STPU) Target

SEMCOG anticipates the STPU target for FY 2025 to be approximately \$19 million. Of this total 69% (approximately \$13.1 million) in STPU funding is allocated for projects on county roads. The remaining 31% (approximately \$5.9 million) is available for Cities and Villages to prioritize projects based on the 3R project rating worksheets.
